#### **Program**

Marion Schoffner joined today to present our program about the Buckeye Trail Association (BTA) that was formed in 1959 to build, maintain, and promote use of the Buckeye Trail for the general public.

The original vision of the a hiking trail from Lake Erie to the Ohio River has grown to 26 sections of trails that stretch across 48 Ohio counties and cover a distance of more than 1,400 miles, making it the longest continuous looped trail system in the country.

Marion's slideshow included a number of pictures depicting the diversity of landscapes covered by the Trail. As explained in the book, "Follow the Blue Blazes", trails are marked by blue stripes painted on trees at regular intervals along the Trail.
